They came from as far away as San Diego May 15, 2002, for "Opening Night" to help launch the new Wednesday Night with Dan & Sandi.


Approximately 80 dancers and guests were there to celebrate the occasion, including Audrey Palmquist and Mickey & Clara Marshall.
